Introduction & Genesis 1-11

DISCUSSION QUESTION: In what ways do the events of Genesis 1-11 help us understand God's desire for relationship with humanity?

DISCUSSION QUESTION: What do these early chapters of Genesis reveal about God's justice and mercy?

DISCUSSION QUESTION: In what ways do the themes of Genesis 1-11 (creation, fall, judgment, mercy, covenant) prepare us for the story of redemption that unfolds in the rest of Scripture?
